

Advent Blessing - Lighting the Candle of Faith

Our to-do lists are long, even in these strange, messy days. We want to do things right, we want to be safe, *and* we want to be able to enjoy the season. As we rush about, preparing our homes and schedules for the coming feast, we are reminded that we also have work to do to put right what has gone wrong, to heal what is broken, to mend the relationships, and to get ready for Christ's arrival.

Still today, John the Baptist and the prophet Isaiah remind us of this work: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God." When God comes in, then healing is to be found, but we need to make the way; we need to open the door into our lives.

We light these candles as a sign of our faith that the God we worship is not far from us and that we can clear the way for that God to come and dwell with us. We light these candles in faith that Christ will arrive among us.
